

Guideline on writing Reading Response for students of Language Teaching Methods

- Read the article carefully, reread it couple of times to get full understanding
- Your reading response is an individual document, keep it private. You are to share it only with the course facilitator.
- Handwrite or type your reading response on A4 paper.
- The maximum number of pages is three (3).
- Name your paper and write your student registered number.
- Refer to the following rubric when writing your reading response.
- Submit your reading response on the 5th, 10th, and 15th meeting **before** class discussion/activity is started. Submission during and after class discussion/activity is not accepted.

Scoring:

Example: a student gets the highest score for all aspects (organization, grammar, and vocabulary), the score will be: $25 \times 100/25 = 100$
